## PUBLIC NOTICE

BY ORDER OF THE FIRE CHIEF

BURN PERMIT SUSPENSION

Starting at midnight June 30th, 2018, all permitted door yard debris, burn barrels, and pile burning will be suspended for the remainder of the 2018 fire season. This ban will stay in effect until such time that current and predicted weather patterns allow it be lifted. The predictions for this fire season warrant that we once again be as pro-active as possible in order to protect the trust resource of the Hoopa Indian Reservation. With the late spring rains, combined with late spring and summer temperature predictions the decision has been made to stop all door yard burning activity.

Please be aware that the Fire Department may identify and conduct burning activities that warrant mitigation to reduce the threat of conflagration. An example of this is to burn the stick field prior to the Sovereign Day Fire Works show. If you have any questions, please contact the Hoopa Fire Department at 530-625-4220, Ext 0 and ask for the Duty Officer.
